DECLARATION OF MARYBETH KELLER


I, MaryBeth Keller, hereby declare and state the following:

1. I am an Assistant Chief Immigration Judge at the Executive Office for Immigration Review (“EOIR”). I have worked in this capacity since 2008. During the time giving rise to the events alleged in the above-captioned cause of action, I was an Assistant Chief Immigration Judge at EOIR.
2. I am aware of the lawsuit filed by Plaintiff Jacqueline Stevens.
3. As an Assistant Chief Immigration Judge at EOIR, I am responsible for Immigration Judge Conduct and Professionalism matters, which involves overseeing and tracking the investigation and resolution of complaints concerning misconduct by immigration judges.

4. As part of my job responsibilities, I receive, review, and monitor the investigation of complaints by supervisory ACIJS concerning misconduct by immigration judges under their supervision.
5. EOIR's internal complaint process related to the alleged misconduct of our immigration judges is crucial to the proper functioning of the immigration court given the importance of ensuring that any misconduct by immigration judges is identified and addressed to prevent it from continuing.
6. On or about April 27, 2010, I received a complaint from Jacqueline Stevens alleging she had been excluded from Atlanta Immigration Court.
7. As part of my job responsibilities and duties, I received and reviewed the April 27, 2010 complaint.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
