1.6 Determining the Age of an Individual without Lawful Immigration Status

The Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act of 2008 (TVPRA) instructs HHS to devise age determination procedures for individuals without lawful immigration status in consultation with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS). *To carry out the TVPRA provision, HHS and DHS worked jointly to develop the age determination policies and procedures in this section.*

Typically, DHS is the agency that apprehends individuals without lawful immigration status, including unaccompanied children (UC). , while HHS is the agency responsible for the care and custody of UC transferred to its care. HHS authority to provide care and custody applies only to individuals who have not attained 18 years of age.

Each agency acknowledges the challenges in determining the age of individuals in custody. These challenges include, but are not limited to:

- Unavailable documentation;
- Contradictory or fraudulent identity documentation and/or statements;
- Physical appearance of the individual; and
- Diminished capacity of the individual.

The TVPRA requires the age determination procedures, at a minimum, to take into account multiple forms of evidence. Accordingly, under these procedures, each case must be evaluated carefully based on the totality of all available evidence, including the statement of the individual in question.

1.6.1 Unaccompanied Children in HHS Custody

HHS may make age determinations of UC when they are in HHS custody on a reasonable suspicion that a child in HHS custody is 18 years or older.

In the event there is conflicting evidence regarding the age of an unaccompanied child in HHS custody, the HHS funded care provider case worker shall immediately notify the HHS Federal Field Specialist (FFS). The FFS will make the age determination based on his/her review of the multiple forms of evidence collected by the care provider. Until the age determination is made, the unaccompanied child is entitled to all services provided to UC in HHS care and custody.

There may be occasions when an unaccompanied child's age is questioned at the time of admission to an HHS funded care provider facility during the intakes process. In those cases, the case

manager does not complete the intakes process, but consults with the HHS FFS to make the age determination.

1.6.2 Instructions

Case managers should seek the following as evidence when conducting age determinations. Information from each category is not required.

Documentation:

- Official government-issued documents, including birth certificates. If the unaccompanied child in question is not in possession of original documentation, or if the authenticity of the original documentation is in question, government officials of the unaccompanied child's home country must be consulted in order to verify the validity of the documentation.
- Other reliable records (e.g., baptismal certificates, school records, medical records) that indicate the unaccompanied child's date of birth.

Statements by individuals (including the unaccompanied child) determined to have personal knowledge of the unaccompanied child's age, and whom HHS concludes can credibly attest to the age of the unaccompanied child:

- Statements provided by the unaccompanied child regarding his/her age or birth date. (Generally, an unaccompanied child's uncorroborated declaration regarding age is not used as the sole basis for an age determination.)
- Statements from the unaccompanied child's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if such persons can be identified and contacted.
- Statements from other persons.
- Information from another government agency (Federal, State, local or foreign):
- State/local arrest records.
- Child welfare agency records.

Medical age assessment procedures (i.e., dental and skeletal [bone] maturity assessments using radiographs) may be used to determine age, but only if other information is inconclusive.

Medical Assessments:

- A medical professional experienced in age assessment method(s) must perform the examination, taking into account the individual's ethnic and genetic background.
- As no medical assessment method can determine an exact age, best practice relies on the estimated probability that an individual is 18 or older. The examining doctor must submit a written report indicating the probability percentage that the individual is a minor or an adult.

ORR Response:

- The FFS supervisor must review the determination regarding the age submitted by the examining doctor.
- If an individual's estimated probability of being 18 or older is 75 percent or greater, ORR will refer the individual to DHS. This applies to all medical methods and approaches identified by the medical community as appropriate methods for assessing age.
- The FFS compiles all pertinent information (e.g., the information referenced, individuals or agencies consulted, statements and conclusions) and documents it in a memorandum for review and approval by the FFS Supervisor.
- The FFS then will forward the memo to the care provider facility case manager to be included in the unaccompanied child's case file and to the ICE Detention and Removal Office (DRO) Field Office Juvenile Coordinator (FOJC) for inclusion in the unaccompanied child's A-file.

At any time, an unaccompanied child in ORR care or his/her designated legal representative may present new information or evidence that he/she is 18 or older for re-evaluation of an age determination. New information will be reviewed and evaluated by the FFS and if necessary, the FFS Supervisor, in a timely manner and shared with the DRO FOJC to determine if current placement is appropriate. If the new information or evidence indicates a presumed UC is actually an adult, then HHS will coordinate with the assigned FOJC to ensure an immediate transfer of custody to an adult DRO facility.

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Footnotes

1. Other circumstances which would result in a longer stay, such as the child's country of origin is in a state of emergency, indicating that the child will likely not be repatriated for an extended period of time.

Good afternoon All,

(b)(6) (hereinafter Mr. (b)(6)) is a Guatemalan citizen admitted to Las Palmas on (b)(6) 2016. Mr. (b)(6) brought with him a birth certificate which identified him with such name, and with the DOB of (b)(6) 1999 (Mr. (b)(6) was admitted with the DOB of (b)(6) 1999 per I-216, see attached "...Altered BC"). Upon initial mental health screening Clinician (b)(6) explained to Mr. (b)(6) the possible consequences of lying about his age, and that the program would request and verify documents that would determine his true identity and biographic information. Mr. (b)(6)

then confessed that he was not a minor, but in fact an adult. Mr. (b)(6) stated that he felt guilty about misleading everyone about his age. Mr. (b)(6) was 20 years old with the DOB of (b)(6)/1996 and that he preferred to tell the truth and find a way to be admitted into the country in good faith.

Case Manager (b)(6) proceeded to obtain a written statement from Mr. (b)(6) which he wrote and is translated as follows, "I am (b)(6) date of birth (b)(6) 1996 declare that I am not a minor in age. My true age is (b)(6) 1996. I confessed to (b)(6) about this 17/12/2016 and to the doctor too, 19/12/2016. Mr. (b)(6) was then isolated from the community and placed on run risk protocol (although he does not present any intention of fleeing).

CM contacted Mr. (b)(6)'s family in Guatemala in order to request his true BC. CM obtained Mr. (b)(6)'s true BC on 12/19/2016 in which in fact his true DOB is transcribed as (b)(6)/1996 – making Mr. (b)(6) 20 years old. This case is being recommended for Age Redetermination; please be advised that we are ready to proceed with transfer of client to ICE custody upon your approval.

Because Mr. (b)(6) confessed to being an adult he was placed on "run risk protocol" he could not leave the facility for x-rays. Please note that Mr. (b)(6) does not have a TB clearance. Mr. (b)(6) had his IGRA taken on 12/19, but results are pending.

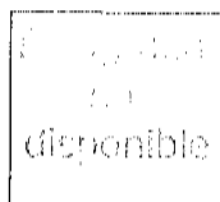

ORR has determined that Guatemalan national, (b)(6), A# (b)(6) (b)(6) is an adult. (b)(6) came into care on December, 17th, 2016 with a birth certificate stating a birth date of April 30th, 1999. Please note that the UC Portal lists his date of birth as (b)(6)/1999.

During an interview with his clinician, the young man confessed that his true date of birth was (b)(6) 1996. The Guatemalan consulate was able to provide the accurate birth certificate and to confirm his true identity.

With the noted findings, ORR is requesting (b)(6)'s apprehension immediately.

The above-mentioned client arrived to SWKEY Glendale on (b)(6) 16. During the initial interview client disclosed that she was from Guatemala and that she was 16 years old with a DOB of (b)(6) 2000.

Client stated that she was planning to be reunify with her Father's second cousin Mr. (b)(6) (b)(6) who currently resides in Dallas, TX.

Assigned Clinician and Case Manager did not have any suspicion/concerns that she may have been an adult due to the fact she does not appear to be physically older and she acts/responds as a regular teenager.

Birth Certificates and Power of Attorney were requested for the client's family in COO and FRP and supporting documents were requested for the potential sponsor. CM attempted to verify the above-mentioned client's BC on the RENAP website using Google Chrome and it indicates "No se encontraron coincidencias con los datos ingresados"; therefore, the authenticity of the document was not validated. CM was still pending to receive all birth certificates to verify the relationship between the father of the client and the potential sponsor.

The assigned Clinician (b)(6) met with the above mentioned client on 5/26/16. The client reported that the information that she provided upon arriving to shelter care does not belong to her. Client reports that due to sexual assault on 3 occasions by a "Narco" named (b)(6) in COO, client attempted to immigrate to the US to be with

her father (b)(6) (who has been the sponsor all along, but as a supposed distant cousin). Client stated she attempted to travel to the US before but was apprehended in Mexico where she was detained for 7 days and then returned to Guatemala. Client reports she did not return home but instead stayed with an uncle of hers whom she begged to allow her to use her cousin's information. Client attested her uncle did not want to do so but eventually ceded and allowed her to use her cousin's information. Client attests her father wanted to help her arrive to the US but was unaware that she was using her cousin's identity until she called him from immigration detention. Client stated that when she spoke to her father, he informed her that her uncle in COO was angry that he had to provide documentation as if his daughter was in the US. Client stated she was afraid of returning to COO due to threats from the "Narco" and his wife, who has threatened to decapitate the client, and that she did not know what else to do.

Client attests her real name is (b)(6) and her true DOB is (b)(6) 1997.

On 05/26/16, LCM (b)(6) called the client's sponsor who confirmed that he is indeed the father of (b)(6) and that although he is Guatemalan, (b)(6)'s mother is Honduran and she decided to register (b)(6) in Honduras. He added/clarified that his family thought it would be helpful to them if they provided the documents of a younger family member and he would like to note that he was not in agreement with doing this; however, he had to go along because the client was already here.

On 06/03/2016 Client's Birth certificate was verified by Consul Alvarado (Honduran Consulate). The birth certificate denotes that the client real name is (b)(6) and her true DOB is (b)(6) 1997.

Client's TB skin test was read on 05/08/16 with negative result for Tuberculosis.

Client's final chest X-ray report was reviewed and signed by medical provider on 05/08/2016 with negative findings of active TB. Client is not pregnant.

The client was attempting to reunify with an unrelated sponsor in NY, allegedly her sister Mrs. (b)(6) as of today her sponsor was never able to provide a full trail of BC's to prove relationship.

During the course of the reunification process several concerns came up, enough to where it was decided that Mrs. (b)(6) should be denied the release of the client.

The assigned CM elevated the case to CFS (b)(6) for BC verification from the Guatemalan consulate as of 7/27/16.

(b)(6) was also transported to SWK Casa Campbell on 7/28/16 for a scheduled consulate interview.

(b)(6) Guatemalan Consulate representative was able to provide verification of the client's true identity as identified by the Guatemalan consulate through their records; as of 7/28/16 the client was identified to be an adult by the Guatemalan Consulate.

On 7/28/16, the client also provided a confession during Treatment Team Meeting with the assigned CM, LCM, CLN and LCLN; the client confessed that the issue with her BC is that it has been altered on the DOB.

The client denied the BC being altered in any other way and indicated that her true DOB is (b)(6) 92 and that she is really 23 years old; this information was immediately provided to CFS for follow up with the Guatemalan consulate.

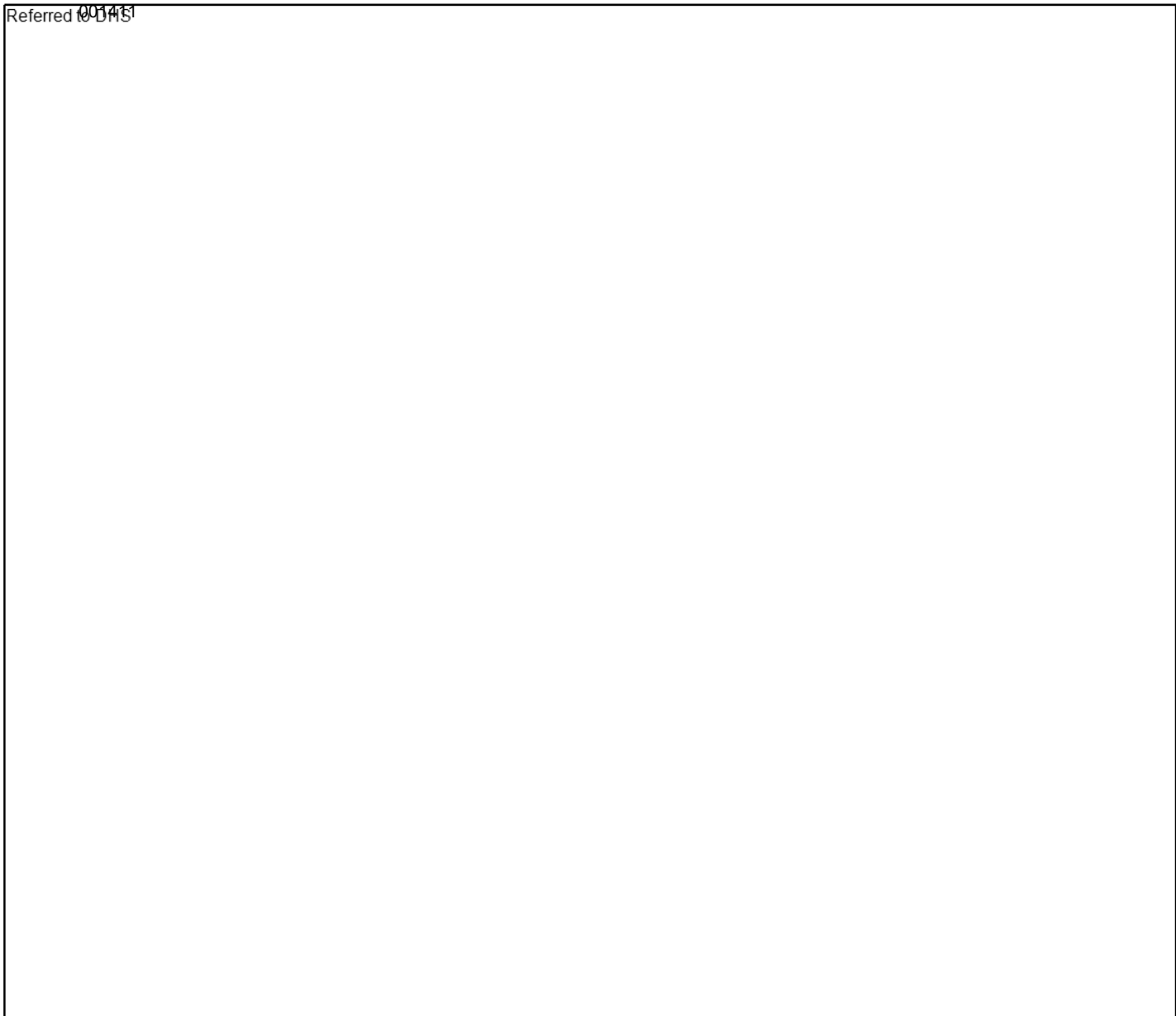

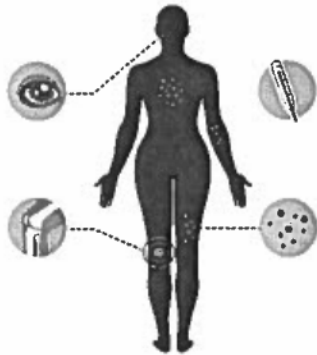

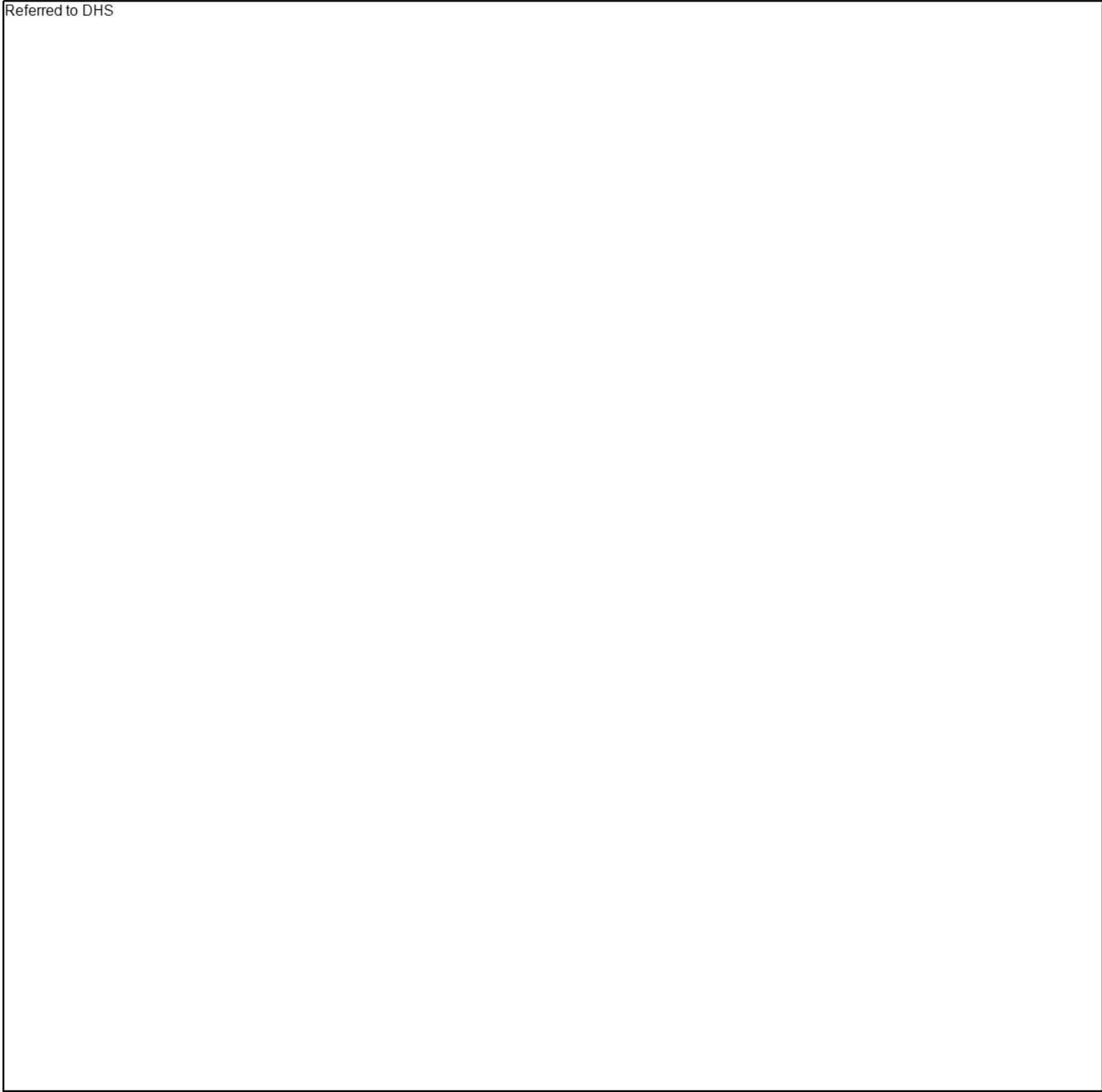

>I would like to follow up with the birth certificate authentication request for (b)(6) A#(b)(6) as we have not receive any updates from the Honduran consulate in regards to the request. A birth certificate authentication is being requested due to a discrepancy between the date of birth on (b)(6)'s BC

and the date in which (b)(6) reports that he was born. Minor reassures to be 17 years old; however, his birth certificate indicates that he was born in (b)(6) 1997, which makes him 18 years old. Please consider the following information:

>1) (b)(6) sponsor, and care giver in home country report that (b)(6) is 17 years old.

>2) According to sponsor and care giver in home country, UC's mother did not know how to read and write. Additionally, she waited for two years to register (b)(6) after he was born. Sponsor and care giver in home country report that a potential mistake could have happened by the time mother registered (b)(6) in home country.

>3) In regards to (b)(6) he reports that he was born in (b)(6) 1999, which makes him 16 years old; however, when he is asked how old he is, he reports to be 17. I have told (b)(6) that based on the date of birth in which he reports he was born he is 16 years old; however, he reassures to be 17 years old. >

>I would like to follow up with the birth certificate authentication request for (b)(6) (b)(6) A#(b)(6), as we have not receive any updates from the Honduran consulate in regards to the request. A birth certificate authentication is being requested due to a discrepancy between the date of birth on (b)(6)'s BC and the date in which (b)(6) reports that he was born. Minor reassures to be 17 years old; however, his birth certificate indicates that he was born in (b)(6) 1997, which makes him 18 years old. Please consider the following information:

>

>1) (b)(6) sponsor, and care giver in home country report that (b)(6) is 17 years old.

>

>2) According to sponsor and care giver in home country, UC's mother did not know how to read and write. Additionally, she waited for two years to register (b)(6) after he was born. Sponsor and care giver in home country report that a potential mistake

could have happened by the time mother registered (b)(6) in home country.

>

>3) In regards to (b)(6), he reports that he was born in (b)(6) 1999, which makes him 16 years old; however, when he is asked how old he is, he reports to be 17. I have told (b)(6) that based on the date of birth in which he reports he was born he is 16 years old; however, he reassures to be 17 years old. (b)(6) appears confused when counting the years leading to his age.

>4) Contact with mother has not taken place, as (b)(6) sponsor, and care giver in home country report to not have any contact information for her.

>5) An interview with the Honduran consulate is also being requested.

>1) During assessment, minor reported that he was born in (b)(6) 1999. This date of birth makes UC 16 years old; however, when minor was asked how old he was, he reported to be 17. Minor was told that based on the date of birth in which he reported to be born he was 16 years old; however, minor reassured to be 17 years old. Minor appeared confused when counting the years to deduce his age.

>2) According to proposed sponsor and UC's care giver in home country, the UC's mother did not know how to read and write. Additionally, she waited two years to register minor after UC was born. Sponsor and care giver report to believe that there was a mistake when registering UC in home country due to UC 's mother waiting for years to register him and not knowing how to read and write. Sponsor and care giver report to be concerned with UC's BC, as they were under the impression that minor was 17 years old.

>3) Care giver and sponsor report to not have any document (baptism certificates, school reports, medical records) indicating that minor is 17 years old.
